



## **Year 7 Catch-Up Premium**

### **What is the Catch-up Premium?**

The Government has made a commitment to provide additional funding to schools for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve the national standard in the Key Stage 2 national curriculum tests in reading and/or mathematics. The purpose of this funding is to enable schools to deliver additional support, such as individual tuition or intensive support in small groups, for those pupils that most need it.

For the Academic year 2017-2018 Rushcliffe School received a total of £11,351 for the Catch-Up Premium.

### **How do we use the Catch-up Premium?**

Additional Teachers and specialist Teaching Assistants have been appointed to English and Maths which allows for small group work and/or 'one to one' tuition. These sessions are tailored to meet student's individual needs and accelerate their progress. (£6000)

As part of our commitment to improving literacy, the School has continued to invest in the library with new books and other resources. A literacy coordinator and other staff work to improve reading for catch-up premium students through the Accelerated Reader Programme. (£1,400)

All students undergo specialist assessment using CAT4 testing to identify barriers to learning. (£2000)

Specialised intervention occurs on a one to one basis to develop Literacy and Numeracy skills. (£2000)
