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# HIGHLIGHTS OF 2013 – 2014

Before delving into the world of raw data we would ask you to gain a picture of our performance by reading the information below:

## KEY STAGE 3 – Teacher Assessments

- Results in Mathematics, English and Science at all levels continue to reflect a high performance.
- Results in all other subjects are well above national averages.

## GCSE RESULTS

- 88% of pupils made expected progress from KS2 in both English and Mathematics.
- 82% of pupils achieved 5 or more A\* - C GCSE's including English and Mathematics.
- Exceptional results showing outstanding progress and deserved achievement by pupils.

## POST 16 COURSES

- Another successful year with an exceptional pass rate.
- 59% of A2 results were A\* - B passes.
- 79% of students accessed universities this year, with 49% of those going to top universities.

**At all stages there are many extremely impressive individual achievements.**

We have continued to build on our outstanding results. This year we have achieved some really outstanding outcomes which reflect a great deal of hard work by students and staff, continuing developments in Teaching and Learning. We strive to treat each child as an individual and to unlock their potential.

Our improvement agenda is based on setting extremely challenging targets (based on nationally agreed criteria) for the school and for individual students. This approach helps to assure that pupils at our school make substantially better progress than pupils who go to similar schools nationally.

## **THE TARGETS**

Definition: Target = Prediction + Challenge

The challenge factor is ambitious and is important in adding value. We continue to put more challenge into our targets and again have surpassed these targets. We achieved well above the achievements expected of similar schools nationally. The targets set will vary from year to year depending on the characteristics of the student cohort and the increasing level of challenge we set.
